




WELCOME TO PARIS-PANTHÉON-ASSAS UNIVERSITY

So, as a student in Melun, you are a student of Paris-Panthéon-Assas University, with access to a modern campus equipped with an extensive library that is conducive to student success.



Undergraduate degree in law

Introduction

The Bachelor's Degree in Law provides students with the basic general knowledge of Law and to become familiar with the methodology specific to lawyers (legal dissertation, commentary on judgements, practical cases).

The structure, objectives and cross-disciplinary approach adopted by Paris-Panthéon-Assas University, makes this a Bachelor's Degree that guarantees a mastery of both basic legal principles, as well as one that fosters a multidisciplinary approach which are indispensable assets for today's modern, competent and efficient lawyers.

Objectives

The aim of this undergraduate law degree is to provide students with a basic knowledge in the legal disciplines, with an outline of specialisation at L3 level, an introduction to the working methods specific to the legal

disciplines, access to basic knowledge about professional practices, the knowledge necessary either for direct entry into certain legal professions, or for the pursuit of a specialised Master's 1st year course.

The "traditional" track is supplemented with language courses, methodological lectures and skills workshops, led by law professionals.

The "success" track enables students to enter the second year of the degree course with a better command of the essential basics of French language, general culture and methodology, thanks to specific tutorials. More than a simple upgrade, the aim is to broaden the students' perspectives via a dense and open-minded curriculum in the form of a compulsory tutoring system.

STUDENT LIFE

INFORMATION AND SOCIAL SPACES

Equipped with screens, these information spaces in each centre provide you with brochures published by Paris-Panthéon-Assas University, which are intended to provide you with guidance for your day-to-day life.



FROM YOUR STUDIES TO A JOB

The CIO (Career Guidance) and the BAIP (Employment Assistance Office) have a regular desk in the Cujas and Reine Blanche centres to help you to think of future academic and career paths, to find out about apprenticeship courses, to benefit from internship offers, to take part in CV workshops, etc.

HEALTH, PREVENTION AND SOCIAL ACTION

The nurse, disability officer and members of the preventive health and social service team welcome you in Paris or Melun, whenever you need advice, to consult a doctor, to obtain a medical certificate or psychological follow-up. A social worker, a psychologist and a relaxation therapist are available on-site once a month.

SPORTS AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES, CLUBS AND SOCIETIES

Sports, music, eloquence: you can express your talent in many ways. You can choose from among 15 sporting activities (such as rowing, badminton, basketball, boxing, swimming, fencing, football, handball, weight training, rugby, tennis, volleyball, athletics and shooting). You can also participate in the various activities organised by student clubs and societies.

DIGITAL SERVICES

With your enrolment you will have access to an email address in the format: firstname.surname@etudiants.u-paris2.fr

You will receive practical information about university life, as well as information relating to your timetable to this email address.

On the University's Agor@ssas platform, you can find course and tutorial materials, discussion forums, multiple-choice questionnaires and corrected tests in English (a compulsory course for L1 law), Mathematics and Statistics, Law and C2i preparation.

There are WiFi points in all centres and at the University library.

You no longer need to go to the university to consult your exam results, look up course outlines and syllabuses, access the document network, etc. Simply log on to the university's website www.u-paris2.fr. You will also find a complete description of all the courses and their opportunities, a lot of practical information, internships and job offers, databases, etc.

THE INSTITUTE FOR EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

A computer room with iMac computers and a printer is available to students. Various legal books and literary works and a DVD library are available for direct access. A programme of cultural trips and first aid training sessions in partnership with the Red Cross are also offered to students.

RESTAURANT AND UNIVERSITY HALLS

The on-site university restaurant is open for lunch, offering an affordable menu.

There are accommodation options at reasonable prices at the Abélard and Bon Temps Halls of Residence, located within easy reach of the Melun campus.



A CAMPUS IN THE TOWN

Ideally located in the heart of Melun, on the Île Saint-Étienne, the 4 university establishments contribute, along with the media library and the museum, to the city's cultural life.



1 REINE BLANCHE SITE, 19 rue du Château

Management, teaching organisation department (lecture timetable and room occupancy), sports department, IEC (Institute for Equal Opportunities), club and society office, 700-seat amphitheatre, lecture rooms, BAIP (Employment assistance) desks, and student life/disability.

2 FRÉTEAU DE SAINT JUST SITE, place Praslin

Examinations department (preparation and organisation of examinations, consultation of papers), university restaurant managed by CROUS of Créteil, amphitheatre with 100 seats, lecture rooms and computer room.

3 CUJAS SITE, quai de la Reine Blanche

- University library with 180 seats, offering 12,000 printed books, a digital library of 20,000 journals accessible remotely, exam syllabuses, lending of books, computers, tablets and USB keys available for self-service, multifunctional devices and printers (paying service), on-site documentary support, a catalogue of all the books owned by the university accessible on: <http://bibweb.u.paris2.fr>, a partnership with the Melun media library (collection of books on deposit);
- Auditorium with 400 seats;
- CIO (Career Guidance) offices.

4 ABÉLARD SITE, rue du Franc Murier

- Academic office (reception, administrative and educational enrolments, fees and scholarships, academic monitoring, educational arrangements, internship agreements), amphitheatre with 200 seats and lecture room
- Social worker's desk

ACCESS

Located 50 km from Paris and 15 km from Fontainebleau, the town of Melun is easily accessible by car or train:

- by train (28 minutes from Paris – Gare de Lyon, direct SNCF line);
- by RER (D);
- by motorway (A5 A and B).
