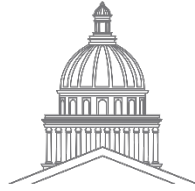

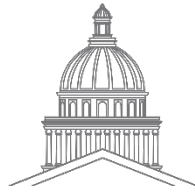

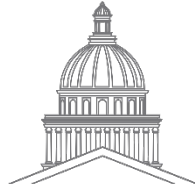
Professor Jean-Christophe Galloux graduated from the University of Burgundy (LLM in Private Law, 1983), the European University Institute of Florence (LLM in European and Comparative Law, 1987) and the University of Bordeaux (Doctorat d'Etat en Droit, 1988). He became a professor at the University of Reims in 1991 and has been elected as a professor of law at the University of Paris 2 Panthéon-Assas (Paris II, member of “Sorbonne Universités”) in 2000, where he holds the Chair in industrial property.

He teaches Intellectual Property Law, Pharmaceutical Law, Competition, and Contract Laws in connection with IP at the Law Faculty of Paris and at the International Centre for Intellectual Property Law of Strasbourg (CEIPI).

He is the author of more than 250 publications in Intellectual Property Law, Competition Law, and Pharmaceutical and Biotechnology Law. He published several books: "Droit de la propriété industrielle" (Dalloz, Paris 2003, 2nd édition, 600 p.) and "Les biotechnologies en débat: pour une démocratie scientifique" (Balland, Paris 2002, 260 p.). Is also co-author with Pr. Jacques Azema of “Droit de la propriété industrielle” (Collection “Précis”, Dalloz, 1100 pages, 8th ed. 2017), which is the leading academic book in this field.

He has been an adviser to the European Commission, UNESCO, and OECD and a member of the European Ethics Committee for EUROPABIO in Brussels (1999-2003). He is a member of the Paris bar since 1984, where he practices Intellectual Property matters.

He also practices arbitration (domestic and international) and mediation. Prof. Galloux has been elected as a Member of the National Academy of Pharmacy.

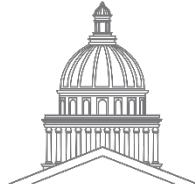


Prof. Marie Goré

He is also Director of DU Contract Management, Head of the International Section of the College of Law, and a Member of the UFR Council for the 2nd and 3rd cycles.



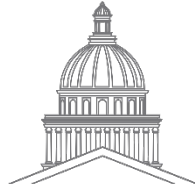

His teaching focuses on Business Law, in its various forms (Corporate Law and Groupings, General Commercial Law, Competition Law, etc.), and the Law of Obligations.



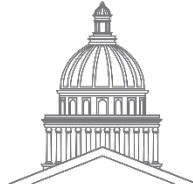
